

## Blue Moon Cruiser Meeting Minutes

July 5, 2011

Park Inn - Mechanicsburg, PA

President John Kaufman called the July 5th Blue Moon Cruiser meeting to order at 7:06pm with 67 attending per the sign-up sheets. Per roll call, all executive board members were present with the exception of Ken Conrad. There were no new members present.

The Secretary's Report was read and 1 item was corrected. The correct date of the Cumberland Valley Motor Show was Thursday, July 7. Glenn Bruner made the motion to accept the minutes, with Dee Hinkle seconding. The motion carried on the vote.

Also, we received Thank-you cards from the family of Carey & Faye Smyers and the Clouse Children Playground Fund for the charitable donation honorariums and from Karen Ladd, Dave Binkley, and Rachel Loy for the cards and gifts received following their surgical procedures. It was also announced that member Paul Freda is in Johns- Hopkins following a bone marrow transplant. Paul and his wife Marla would be there for the next few months and would appreciate encouragement from members. Their home address (also in the roster book) was given out and daughter Julianne would see the mail was sent on the hospital.

Treasurer Glenn Martin presented the June Treasurer's report which began with an account balance of \$22,843.56 as of 6/01/11. Our total income for June was \$3,091.29 and our total disbursements were \$868.09. These combined actions gave us a balance to \$25,066.76. At the rate we are going, we do expect to break even and recognize a profit by the July Fun Run. Following the June dividend payment of \$10.22 the Building Fund CD currently stands at \$10,045.95. Rick Meisel made the motion to accept the Treasurer's report, with Sam Beetem seconding. Upon the vote to accept the Treasurer's report as presented; the vote was unanimous. Motion carried.

### Guest Speakers

1- BMC Member Leon Becker who was sponsoring a car show at **Tires Plus of Lebanon** off of Rt. 422 on Saturday, August 27th from 9:00am - 4:00pm. **Tires Plus** would provide the dash plaques and trophies. There would be a Bounce House for children to play in. Canned food items would be accepted as donations to the local food bank.

2) Denny Martin- of **DAS Distributors of Conway Industrial Park** which is hosting a fund raising event to benefit **Aaron's Acres** for disabled children, scheduled for Saturday, July 23rd from 1:00pm-7:00pm and held at the Lawn Fire Company outside of Elizabethtown. Fliers were provided. They were asking for approximately 8 cars to show as a draw for the benefit, citing there also were vendors and a concert as well. John Forry made the motion to donate \$100 to the event, with Lenard Reisinger seconding. The motion carried on the vote.

**Advertising:** Walt Bradley is gathering advertising for 2012 roster books and asked for assistance from members if they had any advertiser leads.

**Fun Run:** Ken Wyland provided a checklist, with members chiming in on Fun Run progress. We already have 100 cars pre-registered. Chinese Auction Items looked good, as were the door prizes. We discussed ticket color codes based on their function. Ken needed to get the count of tables we needed for the projects - Bake Sale, book sale, apparel sales, etc. Jim Hinkle advised he had a dozen screaming green vests for staff members. Ken also was advised he could check to obtain Filson Water to hydrate staff members during the event. Nelson & Sharon would sell Fun Run T-shirts as they had been at this meeting. The fire stations' mobile

advertising sign had been placed on the Pike. Dorothy Kaufman asked all donated baked goods should be pre-packaged as single servings to allow for quick sales. Someone suggested we should have a schedule of events that would keep us all apprised as to when events were to commence, which Ken said would be provided. John Kaufman also stated at next year's Fun Run the DJ services would be out for bid. Ken & Fun Run staff met after the meeting for final instructions.
